REGISTRATION

1. Youth must reach their ninth birthday between October 1, 2009 and September 30, 2010 and must not have reached their fourteenth birthday before October 1, 2010.
2. Counselor and leadership opportunities are available for Teen and Adult volunteers.
3. Transportation is not provided to and from the Jamestown 4-H Center.
4. There will be a charge of \$25 for all returned checks due to insufficient funds. The fee plus the original amount of the check will be payable by money order or cashier's check only. No exceptions will be made. There are a limited number of openings. Space will be filled on a first-come, first served basis.

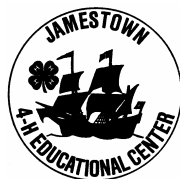

2. A formal camper code of conduct form, a media release form, and health history form will be sent to parents for completion upon the receipt of this registration form accompanied by the \$100 fee.

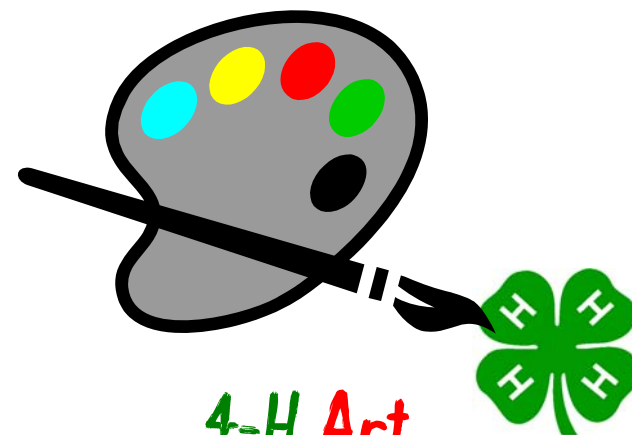
