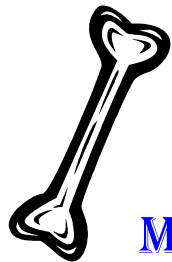


CALLING ALL SCIENCE EXPLORERS

REGISTRATION

1. Youth must reach their ninth birthday between October 1, 2010 and September 30, 2011 and must not have reached their fourteenth birthday before October 1, 2011.
2. Counselor and leadership opportunities are available for Teen and Adult volunteers. Cost for Teens is \$10. Adults are free.
3. Transportation is not provided to and from the Jamestown 4-H Center.
4. There will be a charge of \$25 for all returned checks due to insufficient funds. The fee plus the original amount of the check will be payable by money order or cashier's check only. No exceptions will be made. There are a limited number of openings. Space will be filled on a first-come, first served basis.

CAMP FEE

This year, realizing that families have differing abilities to pay, we are offering a voluntary 3-tier pricing program at the 4-H Center. The first price (\$110) is our historically subsidized rate; \$120 is a partially subsidized rate; \$130 represents the true cost of camp. 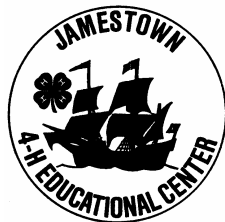

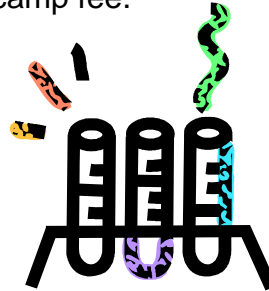
