Youth 14-18 years of age may attend. Youth must reach their fourteenth birthday by September 30, 2010 and must not have reached their nineteenth birthday before the first day of the camp.

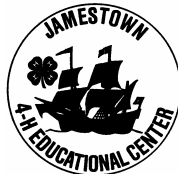

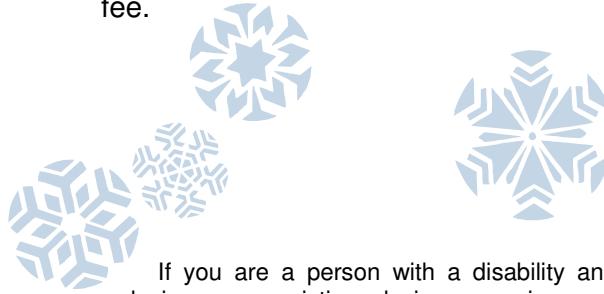
