No camping experience is complete without programs around the fire. Songs, cheers, and stories make these activities come alive for Cloverbud youngsters.

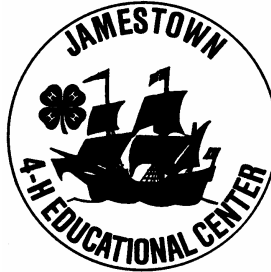
Scheduled activities may include the following:

REGISTRATION

1. Youth 5 - 8 years of age may attend. Youth must reach their fifth birthday between October 1, 2009 and September 30, 2010 and must not have reached their ninth birthday before October 1, 2010.
2. Counselor and leadership opportunities are available for Teen and Adult volunteers. Cost for Teens is \$10. Adults are free.
3. Transportation is not provided to and from the Jamestown 4-H Center.
4. There will be a charge of \$25 for all returned checks due to insufficient funds. The fee plus the original amount of the check will be payable by money order or cashier's check only. No exceptions will be made. There are a limited number of openings. Space will be filled on a first-come, first served basis.

CAMP FEE

This year, realizing that families have differing abilities to pay, we are offering a voluntary 3-tier pricing program at the 4-H Center. Please take a moment to look at the rate descriptions below and determine which of the prices your family is able & willing to pay for your child's camp experience. The first price (\$75) is our historically subsidized rate; \$80 is a partially subsidized rate; \$90 represents the true cost of camp. This program is voluntary (you choose the price), and in no way influences the quality of experience each child receives. Additional financial assistance may be available to ensure all children have this wonderful opportunity to attend camp.

Teen counselor fee is \$10.

FACILITIES AND STAFF

Jamestown 4-H Center is located near Jamestown on the beautiful James River. Campers will be housed in air-conditioned cabins with bunk beds and modern bathroom facilities. Meals will be provided by our food service professionals and served Family Style. Cabins and activities will be chaperoned by both teen and adult counselors with a ratio of one counselor to five campers.

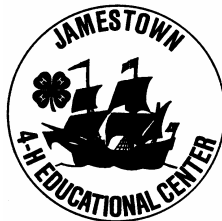
