Boys and girls are welcomed by the Newport News 4-H Program to attend **4-H Junior Camp** for 9-13 year olds during **June 21-25 2010**. Campers leave Newport News by bus on Monday morning and return Friday mid-day.

4-H Camp can offer your child a fun, safe, and challenging experience. Top priority is given to the health, safety and welfare of each camper. Each camp group consists of 180 campers, administrative, staff, qualified and trained college students, certified life guards, emergency medical technicians, full service cafeteria staff, adult volunteers, teen counselors, and professional Cooperative Extension Staff from the cities of **Hampton, Newport News, Westmoreland and Richmond Co.**

Our youth programming provides a safe and well-supervised camping experience. Campers sleep in air-conditioned cabins with bunk beds and bathroom facilities. Jamestown 4-H Educational Center is located in Williamsburg, on 16 acres of wooded and open land that borders the James River.

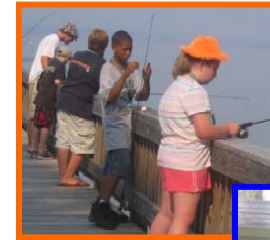
