
It is important that you read this information carefully!

- ALL forms must be complete, including the child's most recent tetanus date (please do not write "Up to Date") in order for your child to be registered. ANY MISSING INFORMATION OR FORMS COULD RESULT IN THE DELAY OF RECEIVING CLASS SELECTIONS.
- Transportation will NOT be provided. Parents will be responsible for getting their children to and from the Jamestown 4-H Center.
- Tuition for campers is \$225. A \$75 minimum deposit is due at the time of registration, No exceptions. Checks should be made payable to VCE-York. Camp tuition balance will be due into the Extension office **no later** than April 30.
- Refund, minus a \$5 processing fee, may be requested until June 16.
- There is a \$10 sibling discount (applies to only one sibling) and a \$50 discount for those campers whose parent stays overnight the full week.
- Residents of other Peninsula localities may register beginning April 1.
- Class Selection and Medication forms will be mailed at a later date. Please watch for these materials and return them as soon as possible.
